- Connect the device only to 12V vehicle voltage with earth connection to the car body.


  This subassembly is not approved for use in trucks or other vehicles with 24V Board voltage.

### Audi A4 8K, A5 8T, Q5 8R

Unscrew the required screws from the glove compartment (Pic. 1 - 3) and separate the original ones Plug-in connections from the CD changer (if available).

Remove the MMI 3G unit (Pic. 4 - Release hook) from the center console and disconnect the original connectors. Start with the help of an executive and with the laying of the AMI cable set in the direction of the glove box.

### Audi A6 4F

Unscrew the required screws from the glove box (Pic.5-6) and separate the original ones Plug-in connections from the MMI 3G unit.

### Connection MMI 3G unit

Connect the 12-pin Quadlock insert to the original connector (Pic.7). Connect the FAKRA connector to the MMI 3G unit (Pic.8).






### Integration glove box

Cut a 4.05 cm x 2 cm opening (Pic.9) into the glove box.

At A4 8K, A5 8T, Q5 8R in the right side wall. For A6 4F, A8 4E, Q7 4L coming from above. Insert the cable set into the cutout opening and push the inside of the cable Cover on.

NOTE: Components must engage correctly (Pic.10).








Press the CAR button (Pic.14). Pic.15 appears in the display








+ (shortly afterwards) CAR and hold them together until Pic.17 Appears on the display. Select DIAGNOSTICS.



Select SETTINGS.






Simultaneously press the buttons marked (X) in Pic.21.
